### Minister's Decision

#### On the Approval of the 2026 Export Quotas Plan for *Aquilaria Crassna* (Plantation Wood)

- Pursuant to the Law on Forestry (Amended), No. 64/NA, dated 13 June 2019;
- Pursuant to the Decree on the Management of International Trade in Aquatic Animals, Wild Animals, and Endangered Wild Plants, No. 299/PMO, dated 5 June 2024,
- Pursuant to the Decree of Prime Minister on the Organization and Activities of the Ministry of Agriculture and Environment (MAE), No: 534/PM, dated: 14 August 2025;
- Pursuant to the letter of the Department of Forestry (DoF), No: 1284/DoF, dated 25 February 2026;

#### Minister of Agriculture and Environment hereby issues the following decision:

**Article 1** Approval is granted for the 2026 Export Quotas Plan for *Aquilaria Crassna* (plantation wood) with the following permitted quantities:

1. Essential Oil: 590 liters/kilograms (five hundred ninety liters/kilogram);
2. Logs: 1,750,000 kilograms (one million seven hundred thousand kilograms);
3. Chips: 2,692,900 kilograms (two million six hundred ninety-two thousand nine hundred kilograms);
4. Wood Waste: 1,220,200 kilograms (one million two hundred twenty-thousand two hundred kilograms);
5. Incense: 200 kilograms (two hundred kilograms);
6. Powder: 1,212,500 kilograms (one million two hundred twelve thousand five hundred kilograms);
7. Cubes/Boxes: 202,000 kilograms (two hundred two thousand kilograms);
8. Extract (Resinoid): 100,000 liters/kilograms (one hundred thousand liters/kilograms);
9. Wood product (soap): 2,000 kilograms (two thousand kilograms);
10. Wood product (Candle): 200 kilograms (two hundred kilograms);
11. Wood product (Pillow): 5,000 kilograms (five thousand kilograms);
12. Wood product (Herbal bag): 3,000 kilograms (three thousand kilograms);
13. Specimen (scientific): 5 kilograms (five kilograms).

**Article 2** Assigns to Department of Forestry, Department of Natural Resources and Environment Inspection and the Capital and Provincial office of Agriculture and Environment Office to coordinate with relevant parties to manage and inspect the harvesting, transportation and export of such quantities of *Aquilaria Crassna* products strictly in accordance with the laws, regulations of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES), to which the Lao PDR is a party. Absolutely avoid taking advantage of opportunities to harvest *Aquilaria Crassna* from the nature forest or to harvest wood from other places without proper permission.
